

Welcome Back Gators!! You can also find much of this information on <u>our website</u>. We are excited to begin the school year. One of our first priorities in the first week will be to provide our 9th graders and new students with orientation and the opportunity to get acclimated in the building. Therefore, <u>only freshmen will attend school on August 15th</u>

Parking Lot Pick-up/Drop-off, Bus Lane Map

The <u>Bus Lane is for buses only before and after school</u>. Please use the through lane adjacent to the tennis courts and east side of the main parking lot for student pick-up and drop-off. Also, please do not drop-off or pick-up students in the teacher parking lot on the east side of the building next to the baseball field.



Student and School Safety

All students will be required to wear and display their school issued ID at all times when on campus. Students must have their ID visible in order to enter the school building and should have them on a lanyard or attached to their person or backpack at all times. All students will also receive a SLHS Gators lanyard(any lanyard is acceptable). Freshman will receive their ID's during orientation and sophomore, junior and senior classes will have theirs done on August 21st.

Closed Campus for 9th Grade Freshman class

SLHS will have a closed campus for the 9th grade freshman class this school year. This means that all 9th grade students are required to stay on campus(either inside the school building on school grounds) for the duration of their school day. All 9th graders should plan on eating lunch at school as this includes no leaving for lunch or during off-blocks. Freshmen who leave school grounds will be subject to discipline. We have made this decision after careful consideration and discussions with both parent and staff leadership groups. Our goal for freshmen is to remain safe and focused on their academics throughout the school day. In addition to keeping students safe at school, this effort has proven to be effective best practice in improving grades, attendance(tardies and

unexcused absences), and student behaviors in the vast majority of Jeffco high schools. If a student is not scheduled for a 1st or 8th Period class, they are permitted to come to school/or leave school in accordance with their class schedule

SCHEDULER NEWS

First semester schedules will be released today at 4 PM. Counselors will be available for schedule changes Monday August 14th from 8am - noon and Tuesday August 15th from 8am - 11:30am. They will keep normal hours starting August 16th but they take lunch from 12 - 12:30 PM daily.

Students are expected to come down during off hours or before classes to seek changes. If a student comes down during class, they will be asked to return to class. As schedules are always full at the start of the year, we only make changes when the level of the class is wrong (ex Algebra I versus Geometry), two classes are in the same period, or you lack 6 classes. We do not make changes based on off hours or for different/extended lunch hours. Further, we can only make changes when the class sizes decrease. As a reminder, every student has the same lunch hour this year as we have only one lunch period.

This school year, all student meals will be free. However, we strongly recommend that you complete the Meal Benefits Application (formerly the Free/Reduced Waiver). If you qualify, you may receive help with: class fees, district athletic fees, parking pass fees, field trips, and test fees. Apply here: Healthy School Meals for All. Questions?
