State Assessments: CMAS Science

CMAS Science is unique to 11th grade students only. This test is aligned to the new Science standards set forth by the state of Colorado. CMAS allows the school to see how we are progressing at teaching these standards and how students are performing on these standards. CMAS is used in conjunction with classroom tests to build a full picture to assess strengths and areas of growth. All

growth and achievement data from CMAS adds another layer to the CDE school report for each individual school in the state. Students at SLHS will be taking CMAS Science the week of April 1-4 in their science course. If a student does not have a science class, they will be pulled at another time to complete the test.
